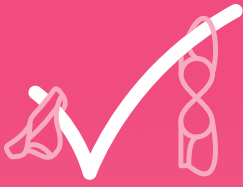

Chick Checks are breast and cervical cancer screenings.

Did you know...

- Early detection saves lives. If found early, nearly all breast and cervical cancers can be treated successfully.
- Mammograms are recommended every two years for women between the ages of 50 and 74.*
- Pap smears (cervical cancer screenings) are recommended every three years for women ages 21 to 65.**
